### From the Pastor

### **Christian Community**

Recently, I've heard a couple prominent thinkers speak, in separate conversations, about the value of Christian Community. This is not so unusual in Christian circles. However, what is surprising is that both of these thinkers are self-professed atheists. Yet, they each recognize the contribution of Christian values, traditions and community to the fabric of society and lament it's decreasing prominence. I find this fascinating.

There are also those within the Christian community who, likewise, lamenting the influence of Christianity on the society have determined that the way to combat this trend is by forcibly exerting Christian culture and values through avenues of power. This can lead to exclusionary practices and vilification of those with differing world views. This seems not only disingenuous, but dangerous and counter to Jesus' way.

Instead, what Jesus taught and demonstrated, is creating community based in radical love and acceptance and undergirded by humility and self-sacrifice—quite the opposite of forceable power. Jesus said to his disciples: "This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends." (John 15:12-13). In the letter of I John chapter 4, the writer says: "Beloved, let us love one another, because love is from God... Those who say, "I love God," and hate their brothers or sisters, are liars; for those who do not love a brother or sister whom they have seen, cannot love God whom they have not seen. The commandment we have from him is this: those who love God must love their brothers and sisters also." Christian Community, based in love, acceptance and the giving of oneself for the sake of the neighbor is desperately needed in today's society. It caught the attention people at the time of the early church and led many to Christ. Perhaps it can do the same today?

#### **Pentecost**

Pentecost is the day we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit. It comes 50 days after Easter and, this year, will be celebrated May 19th.



One of the symbolic events on the day of Pentecost is when the disciples declare the good news in various languages.


